



Tournaments

The purpose is to provide a consistent and documented approach to how tournaments are handled at KBGC so that all involved can have a pleasurable golfing experience and to ensure the continued efficient operation of the course.

- All outside tournaments will be booked through the General Manager or his/her designate.
- Bookings can be made up to 1 year in advance and need to be confirmed 2 weeks prior to the event.
- A 25% deposit is required 2 weeks prior to the event. A lack of a deposit may result in the cancellation of the tournament.
- Refunds will be provided up to 1 week prior to the event. Cancellations made past this time may result in a non-refundable situation. No refunds will be provided within 72 hours of the event.
- No outside tournaments will be booked on Saturdays in July and August and only after 12 noon on Sundays in July and August.
- Shotgun starts may be allowed depending on the number of participants and requires pre-approval from the General Manager or his/her designate.
- No tournament will be booked during regularly scheduled Men's and Ladies' Club tee times.
- Proper attire and footwear are required at all times.
- No outside alcohol is allowed. Arrangements for a beverage cart can be made with the Pro Shop.
- Any tournament participant who causes damage to the property of the Katepwa Beach Golf Club will be required to pay all damages as well as for any costs associated with the damage.
- The Customer ensures that the Katepwa Beach Golf Club and its employees shall not be held responsible for any personal injury or loss or damage to personal property while participating in the tournament.
- Rain or Weather conditions: The Tournament will be played as booked, rain or shine, unless the General Manager or his/her designate deems the course to be unplayable or safety is a factor. At that time a rain check procedure will be initiated between the KBGC and the Tournament Coordinator.
- The KBGC will make every effort to ensure the success of your tournament. The above terms and conditions are not final nor limited.
- It is the responsibility of the Tournament Coordinator to inform all participants of this policy.
