Golf Canada Rules govern all play except as modified by local rules.
Every golfer is asked to know and observe the rules and etiquette of the game of golf

LOCAL RULES

- 1. Golf Carts**
Power and pull carts are not allowed in UNCUT ROUGH
Keep power carts 30ft. From the greens
Keep powers carts on cart paths on hole #3, #4 and #5
- 2. Bunkers**
Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions (Rule 15.2 applies)
- 3. Fairways**
Do not cut across #7 fairway to get to #6 tee box.
- 4. Hole 6 Drop Zone**
A drop zone exists by the forward tees on #6. A player whose tee shot is lost on the hill on the player's left will play their next shot from the drop zone with a one stroke penalty
- 5. Pace of Play**
Please play ready golf and keep pace with the group ahead of you
Please obey the instructions of the course marshal. Management reserves ther ight to instruct slow groups to skip a hole or to **REVOKE WITHOUT REFUND** playing priviledges of players who do nbt follow the course rules.
- 6. Etiquette**
Please play a set of tees that is realistic to your abilities. Please allow no more than 3 minutes to look for a lost ball

INFORMATION

- 1. Stay Visible**
On holes #2, 4, 6 and 9 your tee shot may come to rest where it is not visible to the group behind you. If so, for your own safety levea a cart or bag or have a member of your group remain where they are visible until you have moved out of range
On hole #7 players using the blue or black tees should check to see if the forward tee has cleared before hitting their tee shots. Playres using the forward tees should park where theya re visible to p0layers on the blue or black tees.
- 2. Ring the Bell**
On hole #6 when you pass the bell, located on the right side of the fairway about 140 yards from the green, please ring the bell to let the gorup following you know you are out of range. Players using the back tees shold wait until they hear the bell before hitting
